# EDINBURGH AND THE SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS BY SCENIC RAIL

### Day 1: Welcome to Inverness

Check-in at the 4-star <u>Inverness Palace and Spa Hotel</u> located on the scenic Ness River. Depending upon traveler arrival time, we will set a time to meet to get to know our travel companions. Our licensed, professional guide greets us at the hotel for a for a walking tour. Hear the stories of rebellions, witchcraft, prophecies, clans, Jacobite curses and yes, the Beatles.

### Day 2: Loch Ness, Urguhart Castle, Culloden Battlefield

Today is a day for castles, monsters, "Outlander", and Scottish lore. The finest way to see Loch Ness is with a deluxe water cruise. There are indoor and outdoor viewing areas for your pleasure. The ship is sonar-equipped to detect any mysterious underwater activity and after visiting the fully stocked bar on-board, The Professor guarantees a sighting of the Loch Ness monster! Nothing says "castle" like famous Urquhart Castle. It has seen great conflict in its 1,000-year history as it passed back and forth between the Scots and English during the Wars of Independence. We finish the day by traveling to the site of the 1746 Battle of Culloden between the Jacobites and British armies that marked the dismantlement of Highland Society. Be treated to beautiful scenery, a tour of the famed castle, falconry, majestic gardens and a great day out in the Highlands. On the way back to Inverness, visit the famed Glenmorangie Distillery for a tour and tasting.

## Day 4: Kyle of Lochalsh and Isle of Skye Day Trip by Scenic Rail

This might be the most scenic train ride you have ever been on. Roll through stunning landscape from Inverness to Kyle of Lochalsh. Visit the Royal Mile, Princess Street Gardens, St. Giles (where Queen Elizabeth lay in rest), Calton Hill and more. After lunch, go to the dominating fortress of Edinburgh Castle. ### Day 8: St. Andrews Day Trip
